

MBYC/CMC rules for the use of the clubhouse, launching ramp, parking lot, dumpster, docks, pool and shower/head facilities.

These rules are in addition to the "Use Restrictions" outlined in the Declaration of Unit Ownership Article XIX. These are draft rules and have not been approved by the BoD or the membership.

Guest (Visitor) Rules

THE CLUB FACILITIES ARE RESERVED FOR USE BY THE CAROLINA MARLIN CLUB ASSOCIATION, INC. dba MOREHEAD BEAUFORT YACHT CLUB ("CLUB") OWNERS, ASSOCIATE MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS. YOUR CLUB KEY AND/OR MEMBERSHIP CARD ARE REQUIRED FOR IDENTIFICATION WHEN USING CLUB FACILITIES.

1. Current year dues must be paid to use the club facilities. Members' children and/or grandchildren under the age of 21 and/or dependent adult children are included in the owner and associate member membership.
2. Members are allowed to have up to 4 guests per visit.
3. Guests are allowed a total of 4 visits per year. After a guest has visited a total of 4 times, the member(s) who brought the guest should extend an invitation to the guest to become an Associate Member. (We encourage guests who enjoy the use of our facilities to become Associate Members.)
4. Guests must be accompanied by a member or have the member's key or membership card when using the club facilities. Family members or guests under the age of 21 who enter the clubhouse must be accompanied by an adult member who is 21 years or older.
5. When a member wants the BOD to send a letter of invitation to a guest/potential member, he should contact the BOD designee. If a member has a concern about the number of times a guest has visited the club, the member should contact the BOD designee to voice the concern. The BOD will address the concern using the "Procedure for Handling Rule Violations".
6. Members must contact and make arrangements through the "Club" Events Coordinator if they want to use the Clubhouse facilities to entertain more than 4 guests at one time.

Clubhouse Rules

These rules are intended to enhance the safety and comfort of all members and their guests.

1. No smoking is permitted inside any building at any time.
2. Pets are not allowed inside any building.
3. Members are responsible for their guests behavior at all times.
4. Family members or guests under the age of 21 who enter the clubhouse must be accompanied by an adult member who is 21 years or older. This is required by NC State ABC law.
5. Wet clothing is not allowed inside the Clubhouse.
6. The "Club" is not responsible for any personal property.
7. Property owned by the "Club" cannot be removed from any building or grounds.
8. A member using the Clubhouse facilities is responsible for cleaning after use by themselves and their guests and replacing furniture to its original location.
9. MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY, AND TO ENSURE THEIR GUESTS COMPLY, WITH THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA ABC RULES AND REGULATIONS WHEN USING OR CONSUMING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
 - a. The use of alcoholic beverages is self-regulated and restricted to use and consumption by persons who are 21 years of age or older.
 - b. NCABC rules and regulations require that each bottle of alcohol be labeled with the owners name and remain in a secured storage locker when not in use.
 - c. DO NOT leave unattended alcohol in the refrigerator or any other place in the Clubhouse or on the common area of the "Club" grounds.
 - d. The "Club" maintains several lockers intended for the storage of alcoholic beverages in the Clubhouse and are rented to members on an annual basis. If you rent a "liquor locker", please ensure that it is locked when you leave the Clubhouse.
10. The "Club" reserves the right to suspend privileges to members and their guests whose conduct is found to be in disregard of the rules, is offensive, abusive or unsafe. The Carolina Marlin Club Association, Inc., Procedures for Handling Rules Violations, adopted May 2006, will be consulted in this eventuality. All members have an equal responsibility to ensure safe and appropriate conduct on Club property.

Ramp Rules

1. Your ramp privileges are only for you and your boat. Please don't loan your key to others, including friends, neighbors, relatives or business associates with boats. If non-members loan their key out, their privileges for using the ramp can be revoked without a refund.
2. Lock the ramp after your have launched your boat.
3. Please limit your time to 1 hour when using the courtesy slip next to the boat ramp.
4. Non-members cannot park their vehicle on MBYC property. Non-member vehicles and boat trailers must be parked off MBYC property.
5. Members, please move your boat trailer off site after you have launched your boat. Owner members may store their boat trailer in the designated MBYC trailer area on Island Drive. Short-term trailer parking slots for owners are provided, as well as yearly leased trailer parking slots for \$150/year.

Parking Lot and Dumpster Rules

1. The maximum vehicle parking interval is 72 hours, unless the slip owners and their guests or slip renter are using their boats. If the slip owners and their guests or slip renter are going on an extended cruise (more than 72 hours), and leaving their vehicle on MBYC property, the vehicle(s) should be parked in the paved lot on the East side of the Clubhouse.
2. Bicycles are to be removed from the rack after 72 hours.
3. The dumpster is for use by boaters only. Please do not use the dumpster for your household or business trash. Please follow the rules and guidelines posted on the dumpster.

Marina & Dock Rules

Read and review the MBYC Marina/Boat Preparedness Policy

1. The marina is for the exclusive use of club members, their guests and slip renters.
2. Swimming in the marina is prohibited.
3. No fishing or cast netting from the docks.
4. Unsupervised children under 18 and not allowed on the docks.
5. Bicycle, skateboard, or scooter riding is NOT ALLOWED on the docks.
6. All trash must be placed in trash receptacles.
7. A "closed head" is mandatory on all boats in the marina basin.
8. All boats must be properly insured and proof of insurance must be provided to the Board of Directors.
9. No structural changes shall be made to the docks without the written approval of the Board of Directors.
10. Each boat owner shall, at all times, maintain the dock around his slip in a neat and clean condition. No personal property shall be allowed to remain on or around the docks.
11. Dinghies must be stored in the dinghy rack. All dinghies must be registered with the Club Treasurer.
12. At no time is the Club responsible for damage to any boat.
13. Slip owners renting their slips will be financially responsible for ensuring that their renter who uses the Clubhouse and pool is an associate member.
14. Non-member slip renters may only use the bathrooms by the pool.
15. Please pick up after your pet.
16. Unlicensed drivers may not operate motorized vehicles on MBYC property.

Pool Rules

Please take a moment to review the “Club” and NC Health Department pool rules and regulations which are posted at the west entrance gate and on the pool building. These rules are intended to enhance the safety and comfort of all members and their guests.

1. Current year dues must be paid for a member and their guests to use any of the pool facilities. Members' children and/or grandchildren under the age of 21 and/or dependent adult children are included in the owner and associate member membership as well as a babysitter/care provider 18 years of age or older only while babysitting.
2. Please sign up under the canopy when you enter the pool area. Please include yourself and your guests, and a phone number to contact in case of an emergency. **SIGNING IN IS A SAFETY PRECAUTION FOR YOU AND YOUR GUESTS AND SHOULD NOT BE IGNORED.**
3. Guests(Visitors)
 - a. Members are allowed to have up to 4 guests per visit.
 - b. Guests are allowed a total of 4 visits per year.
 - c. After a guest has visited a total of 4 times, the member(s) who brought the guest should extend an invitation to the guest to become an associate member.
 - d. If a member has concern about the number of times a guest has visited the pool facilities, that member should contact the Board of Directors(BOD) to voice the concern. The BOD will address the concern using the “Procedure for Handling Rule Violations”.
4. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a person 18 years of age or older who will be responsible for child behavior.
5. Persons who are using the pool while babysitting a member’s children must be at least 18 years old. Pool usage while babysitting is restricted to include the care provider and the member’s children.
6. Pets must be kept outside the poll enclosure (fence).
7. Running and horseplay are prohibited on any “club” property.
8. All devices or toys used inside the pool enclosure must be classified as an approved life saving device. Hardboards and large rafts are prohibited. Noodles, soft toys for children and rubber dumbbells used during an exercise class are acceptable.
9. Bicycles, scooters and skateboards must be left outside the pool enclosure.
10. Bathing suits must be worn when swimming. The pool is off limits for children in diapers that are not specifically designed for in-water use.
11. Swimming lessons may be taught at the pool provided the instructor has approval from the Board of Directors and pays a usage/rental fee. Swimming lessons do not have exclusive use of the pool. Members may swim during lessons.
12. The “Club” reserves the right to suspend pool privileges to members and their guests whose conduct is found to be in disregard of the rules, is offensive, abusive

or unsafe. The Carolina Marlin Club Association, Inc., Procedures for Handling Rules Violations, adopted May 2006, will be consulted in this eventuality. All members have an equal responsibility to ensure safe and appropriate conduct on Club property. NC Health Department Pool Rules

1. NO RUNNING
2. NO BOISTEROUS OR ROUGH PLAY
3. NO DIVING ALLOWED
4. CHILDREN SHOULD NOT USE THE POOL WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION
5. ADULTS SHOULD NOT SWIM ALONE
6. NO PERSON UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS SHOULD USE THE POOL.
7. NO PERSON WITH SKIN, EYE, EAR OR NASAL INFECTIONS ALLOWED IN THE POOL
8. NO PERSON WITH COMMUNICABLE DISEASE SHOULD USE THE POOL
9. NO ANIMALS OR PETS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR ON THE DECK
10. NO GLASS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR ON THE DECK
11. ALL PERSONS USING THE POOL DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. OWNERS AND MANAGEMENT ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES.
12. POOL IS FOR PRIVATE USE, MEMBERS AND GUESTS ONLY.
13. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY USE OF THE POOL TO ANYONE AT ANYTIME.
14. THE POOL IS OPEN FROM 9:00 A.M. TO DUSK.
15. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SWIMMERS IN THE POOL IS 25.
16. FIRST AID KITS ARE LOCATED IN THE CLOSETS IN BOTH THE MEN'S & WOMEN'S POOLSIDE BATHROOMS.
17. AN EMERGENCY TELEPHONE IS LOCATED ON THE OUTSIDE WALL OF THE CLUBHOUSE FACING THE POOL.

Shower/Bathroom Guidelines

1. Please lock the bathroom/shower door after use. Help save on utilities and maintenance by not leaving doors open.
2. Do not leave clothes, soap or shampoo in the showers. Any left items will be tossed.
3. Please clean/wipe up after yourself after using the sink.
